Since the beginning of the year, artists, friends and flatmates Ellie Harrison & Oliver Braid have been working together to broadcast a weekly radio show live from their flat in Glasgow every Friday lunchtime. The **Ellie & Oliver Show** is now well-loved for its informal and sometimes outrageous discussion exploring the philosophies that surround and inform its co-hosts everyday lives.

Over the summer, they took their show on the road as artists-in-residence at the Edinburgh Art Festival, broadcasting live from Edinburgh every Friday throughout August and hosting Ellie & Oliver's Afternoon Special – a daytime disco / takeover of the festival pavilion. This autumn they curate Friendship Festival for Glasgay! 2012, inviting six other 'couples' from around the UK to visit their flat and make their own special broadcast in a similar style.

Over the course of three weekends, six carefully selected duos will join Ellie & Oliver to guest host their own half-hour radio shows discussing themes central to their relationships and issues close to their hearts. Representing a variety of voices from across the LGBT community and different cultural perspectives from all corners of the UK, **Friendship Festival** aims to explore the powerful union of friendship and the diversity of forms it can take.
